These documents can be hand delivered to any Committee member or mailed. You will also be notified by a member of the Service and Education Committee if any additional information is needed.

The following items **MUST** be completed and returned:

- Obtain (an official or unofficial) transcript from your attending high school. All completed courses, grades and GPA must be 3.0 unweighted.
- Acquire two (2) letters of recommendation from a teacher, pastor, community service organization or someone in an authoritative role that has had an impact on your life.
- Include a copy of the acceptance letter from the college/university/vocational training school you intend to enroll in.
- Obtain a letter or copy of the community service log sheet documenting you have competed at least seventy-five (75) hours of community service within your high school years.
- Prepare a written 500-word essay titled "Where do I see myself in the next five (5) years?"
- Send a 250-word essay on your biography/profile.
- All documents MUST be mailed, or hand delivered on or before the deadline July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
